

BIOSKETCH: EDOARDO ALESSE

Edoardo Alesse, MD PhD, was born in Leonessa (RI), Italy on February 17th 1958. He received his MD degree (Honours) at the University of L'Aquila and after training in General Pathology he obtained his PhD at the University La Sapienza of Rome. He was visiting fellow from 1989 to 1994 in the lab of Pathology-Gene regulation section, NCI-NIH, Bethesda, MD, USA. He served as Associate Professor of Clinical Pathology (1998-2001)) and later as Full Professor of General Pathology (2001-2012) at University of L'Aquila. From 2013 he is full professor of Medical and Biotechnology Laboratory Techniques. From 2009 to 2012 ha was Director of the Department of Experimental Medicine e from 2012 to 2018 he was Director of the Department of Biotechnological and Applied Clinical Sciences. From 2005 to 2012 prof. Alesse was Coordinator of the of the doctoral programme in Biotechnology and from 2012 to date of the doctoral programme in Experimental Medicine, From 2010 to 2018 he was member of the Academic Senate and from 2018 to date board member of L'Aquila University. In June 2018 he was elected Rector of the University of L'Aquila. Professor Alesse's major scientific interests are oriented mainly towards experimental and translational medicine.
